TASTING NOTES:

Aged for a minimum of 30 months. This authentic, dry, sparkling wine is pleasant, fresh and fruity. A pleasant bubbly with slight mineral quality that adds to its complexity. The sparkling wine can be enjoyed on any day, not just special occasions!

REGION:

The Rheingau Region is located in Southwest Germany. Despite the smaller size, it is the most famous wine growing regions of Germany dating back to the middle ages. The region has ideal climatic conditions, soils and distance to the Rhine River for vineyards to thrive.



SOILS:

The soils consist of a variety of forms. These include chalk, sand, gravel, several clays, loess, quartzite and slate.
