TASTING NOTES:

This lovely Rose' is a burst of juicy raspberry aromas resembling a freshly picked basket of ripe berries. These aromas might be complemented by subtle hints of citrus and floral notes, such as rose petals or hibiscus. A delightful and refreshing wine, perfect for warm weather sipping or pairing with light and fresh cuisine.

REGION:

The Rheingau Region is located in Southwest Germany. Despite the smaller size, it is the most famous wine growing regions of Germany dating back to the middle ages. The region has ideal climatic conditions, soils and distance to the Rhine River for vineyards to thrive.



SOILS:

The soils consist of a variety of forms. These include chalk, sand, gravel, several clays, loess, quartzite and slate.
